### HDSA CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE NETWORK HAS EXPANDED TO 67 SITES

This year the Huntington's Disease Society of America has expanded its HDSA Center of Excellence network of comprehensive care clinics with 56 grants totaling more than \$2 million. In addition to the 56 grant funded facilities, eleven regional partner sites were also named, ensuring expert HD care at 67 distinct medical facilities in 36 states across the nation and Washington, DC.

#### WHAT IS A CENTER OF EXCELLENCE?

The HDSA Centers of Excellence are institutions that provide an elite team approach to Huntington's disease care and research. Patients benefit from expert neurologists, psychiatrists, social workers, therapists, counselors and other professionals who have extensive experience working with families affected by HD and who work collaboratively to help families plan the best HD care program throughout the course of the disease. Applications to become an HDSA Center of Excellence are open to all clinics in the United States who share HDSA's commitment to high-quality, comprehensive care and access to clinical research.
