### TO HUNTINGTON'S DISEASE HUMAN BIOLOGY PROJECTS


The Huntington's Disease Society of America announced that three research grants have been awarded under the Society's largest research initiative, the *HDSA Huntington's Disease Human Biology Project*. These grants represent HDSA's patient-centric research focus which brings basic and clinical researchers together to facilitate Huntington's disease science in the human condition – instead of in animal models – with the direct participation of people affected by HD.
