Please join us on September 18th, 2024 for a very special 24 hour day of giving dedicated to Marjorie Guthrie, her legacy, and the movement she inspired that led to the establishment of HDSA.

57 years ago, on September 18, 1967, the Committee to Combat Huntington's Disease (CCHD) - which later became Huntington's Disease Society of America (HDSA) - was incorporated in New York state.

At the helm, Marjorie Guthrie, the widow of folk musician Woody Guthrie, began a movement for HD families that continues on today through HDSA's mission: to improve the lives of everyone affected by HD and their families. On Founder's Day, we honor Marjorie and her legacy by raising critical funds, voices, and awareness for the HD community all over the country, and across the world.


2024 San Francisco Team Hope Walk Info

HDSA Centers of Excellence provide a multidisciplinary team approach to Huntington's disease care. Patients benefit from expert neurologists, psychiatrists, social workers, therapists, counselors and other professionals who have extensive experience working with families affected by HD and who work collaboratively to help families plan the best HD care program throughout the course of the disease. Applications to become an HDSA Center of Excellence are open to all clinics in the United States who share HDSA's commitment to high-quality, comprehensive care and access to clinical research. There are currently 56 HDSA Centers of Excellence and 11 Partner Sites covering 36 States plus the District of Columbia.

ONLINE SURVEY: INSURANCE FOR PEOPLE WITH HD

Whether you are diagnosed with or are at-risk for Huntington's Disease, the decision to pursue life, long-term care, or disability insurance is a difficult one. Researchers for the UT Health Houston are looking to better understand the experiences of those pursuing these specified insurances, including motivating factors and barriers faced in obtaining these insurances.

HOW YOUTH CAN GET INVOLVED WITH HD RESEARCH

Studies of drugs to treat Huntington's disease have been primarily focused on adults, but the ultimate goal is to treat or even prevent HD symptoms in everyone who carries the gene. In order for trials and treatments to occur earlier and in younger people, it is essential that researchers gain a better understanding of the developing brain in people at risk for HD, and this is where youth from HD families can have a big impact.
