RESEARCH NEWS ROUNDUP

HEALTHCARE PROVIDER OUTREACH

The Healthcare Provider Outreach Committee recently completed a major outreach activity, with a 1,200-piece mailing that dropped on May 7th. The mailing was addressed to CA Department of Public Health Licensed and Certified Healthcare Facilities and members of the California Association of Health Facilities (CAHF). Last year the committee had sent around informational resource emails to a similar

list of Healthcare Professionals across the area, and this year they decided to expand the effort to a mailing containing trackable QR codes that lead to information. This mailing contained flyers about HD educational resources, information about our Bay Area Centers of Excellence, and a flyer for our educational seminar with Dr Bendixon (which we spoke about in last month's newsletter). We would like to thank these committee members for their contributions to our outreach efforts in the Bay Area - so thank you to: Scott Song, Stephen McConoughey, Tanvir Kaur, Jung Hyun Yoo, Kelsee Furagganan and Jay Denhart-Lillard. The printing and mailing cost about \$1,300, and if you'd like to help provide funds to cover it, you're welcome to reach out to Jay.

Last month the HDSA Center of Excellence at Stanford University held a Virtual Education Day on May 7th. Topics included the treatment and care for people with HD, research and study progress, support for the community and a question and answer session with a social worker and genetic counsellor. The session was very well received and attended by 40 users (it's not always possible to know if more than one person is watching per user login for these sessions, so it is possible that more people were in attendance). The Affiliate congratulates Stanford for all their work to create another great day of education for our Bay Area HD families. This event was funded by the Huntington's Disease Society of America with support from Genentech, Neurocrine Biosciences, Sage Therapeutics and uniQure.

Things continue to move forward at the HDSA Center of Excellence at The University of California, San Francisco. Our great partner and star Research Coordinator, Julia Glueck will be moving on to grad school, so she has been training her replacement, Zach Lamson. We welcomed Zach to the community in our last volunteer meeting and wish Julia the best of luck in the next phase of her journey!

As a reminder, all HDSA Center of Excellence clinics must have an expert clinical director (typically either a neurologist or psychiatrist) that understands HD - which is not always the case in any given clinic, even larger centers. HDSA Centers of Excellence are also connected with the collaborative global HD research community that is working together to develop effective treatments for HD. The unique structure of the HDSA Centers of Excellence program helps to enhance outreach to beyond just the patient, to the family/caregiver and local health professionals.
