NEW AND NOTEWORTHY IN THE HD COMMUNITY

MESSAGE FROM OUR AREA HDSA CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE:

Have you been staying away from clinic? Consider coming back!

At our last volunteer meeting on March 2nd, both the UCSF HDSA Center of Excellence and the Stanford HDSA Center of Excellence emphasized the importance of staying in touch with the care teams at your local HD clinic.

Although COVID-19 hit our community hard, both sites have moved to offer more telehealth services, and over the last months have been able to start seeing patients in clinic again safely. Some new studies have started enrolling patients, looking for pre-symptomatic or early symptomatic individuals to help them learn about the progression of HD. And more trials are likely coming down the pipeline, investigating new methods of action for treatments to fight against the disease.

And don't forget the ongoing need for participation in observational trials like Enroll HD, which not only bring information to researchers about the natural history of HD, but are also often used to help find patients for interventional trials. So please be encouraged to consider enrolling in an observational trial if you are able.
